The Department of English organized “Project Punch 50.0” three days spoken English program in collaboration with the Beehive Communication Club from 21st to 23rd June, 2023. The Spoken English class aimed at encourage students to learn and explore English skills to enhance their communication skills for all the final year students.

The program was inaugural with a prayer song on 21st June, 2023. Our college Principal Dr. R.D. Thilaga delivered the welcome address. Rev. Dr. S. Victor Antonyraj secretary of DBCAS, honoured Mr. Radha Krishnan, Assistant Governor of Rotary. Rev. Fr. Peter Arockiaraj, Co-Ordinator of DBCAS honored Mr. Prabhakaran, Assistant Governor of Rotary. 



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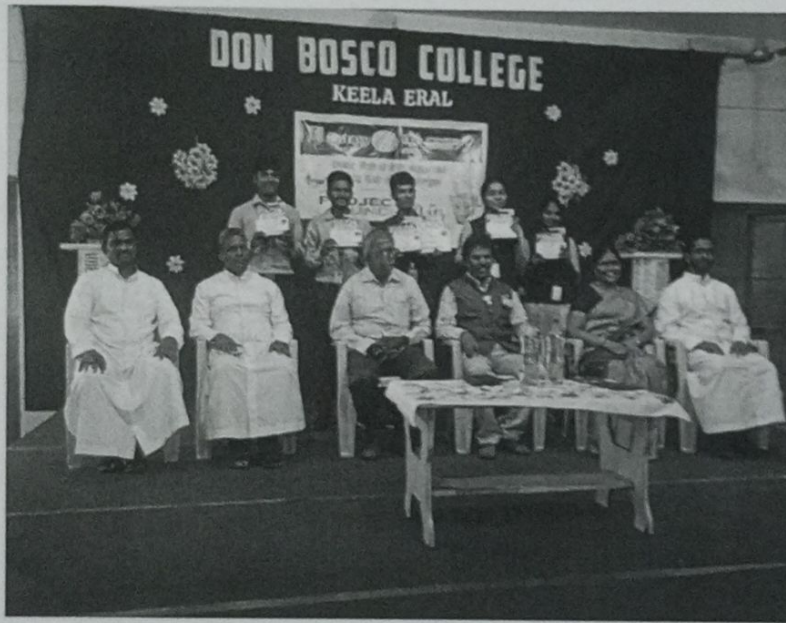



The course was conducted for three days with the strength of 104 students. The students were divided into three groups. The first group of students were from BCA, B.Sc., the second group of students from B.Com, B.A - Tamil and the third group of students were from B.A - English, BBA and MA - English. On the first day, they taught Language Skills, second day they taught pronunciation, and third-day Speaking Skills were taught to the students with peer evaluation. All the students were interested in learning English with great enthusiasm, and the staff members paid attention to the needs of the students and contributed their best for the learning of the students.

INTRODUCTION:

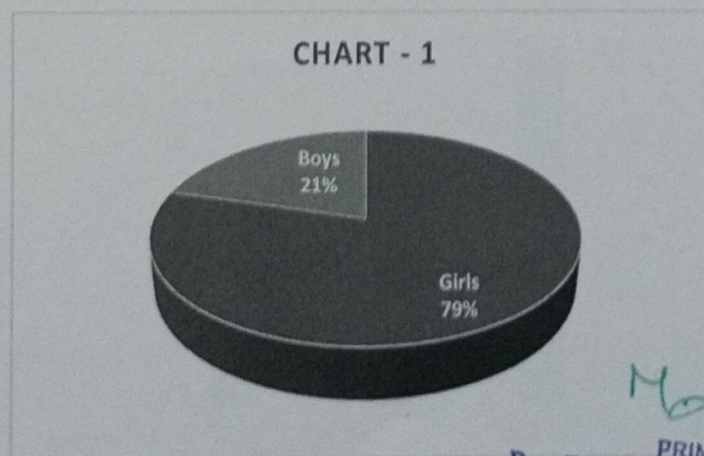
The college offered various courses like B.A., B.Com., B.Sc., BBA., and BCA at under Graduation level and M.A., at Post- Graduation level. At present, over 337 students are studying in college. The Department of English organized “ **Project Punch 50.0**” three days training program on spoken English collaboration with **Beehive Communication Club** for all the UG and PG final year Students. The course was conducted for three days (June 21 – 23, 2023) 104 Students participated. In order to analyze the benefits and scope for further improvement, feedback has been received from students.

DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS

An effort was made to receive feedback from students. For this purpose, a feedback form was provided. As many as 96 students’ responses have been received from the students. In order to arrive at comprehensive results, useful statistical tools like percentage, etc. have been used. For the effective presentation of the data, various types of graphs have been used.

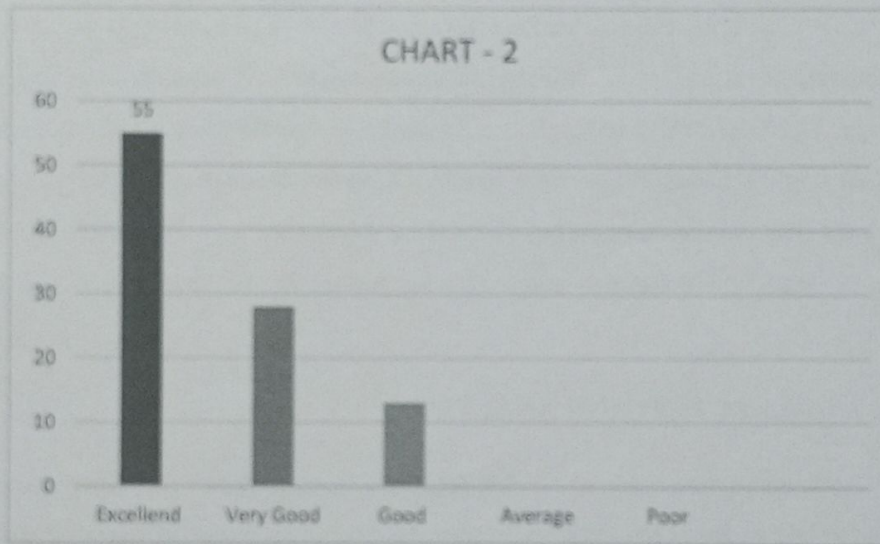
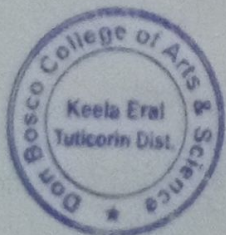
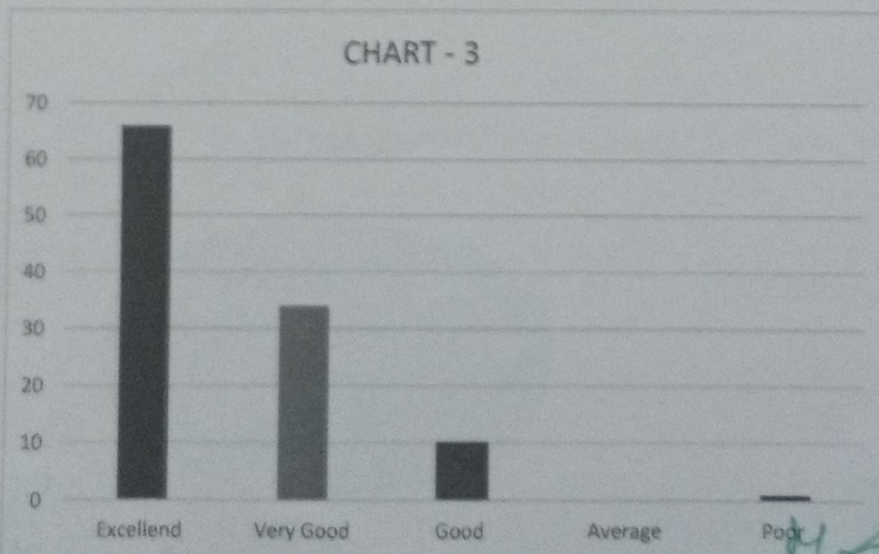

3. The course instructors provided sufficient feedback and guidance to help me improve my spoken English skills.

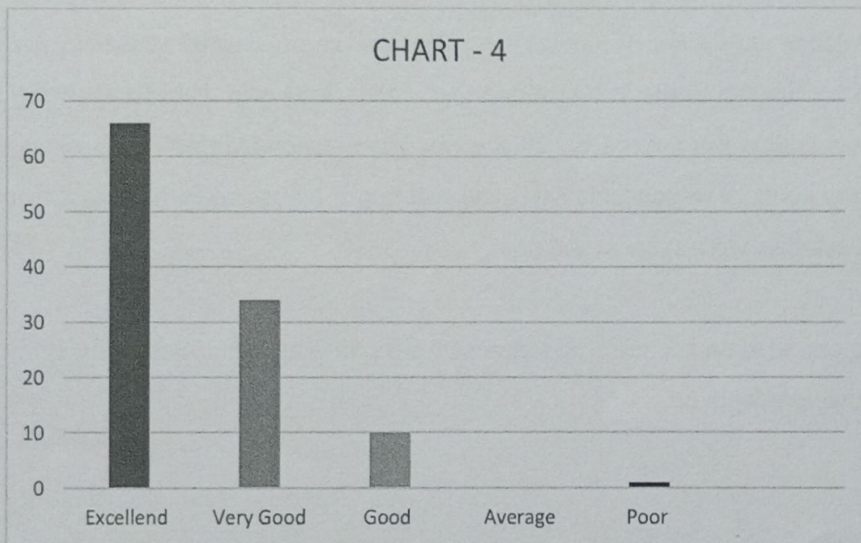

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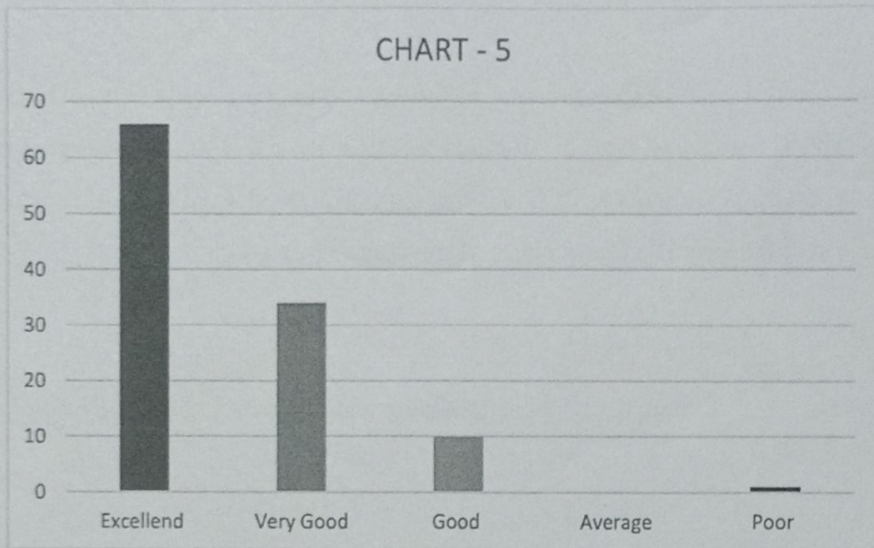

5. The course provided an adequate opportunity for me to practice speaking English in a supportive and constructive environment.

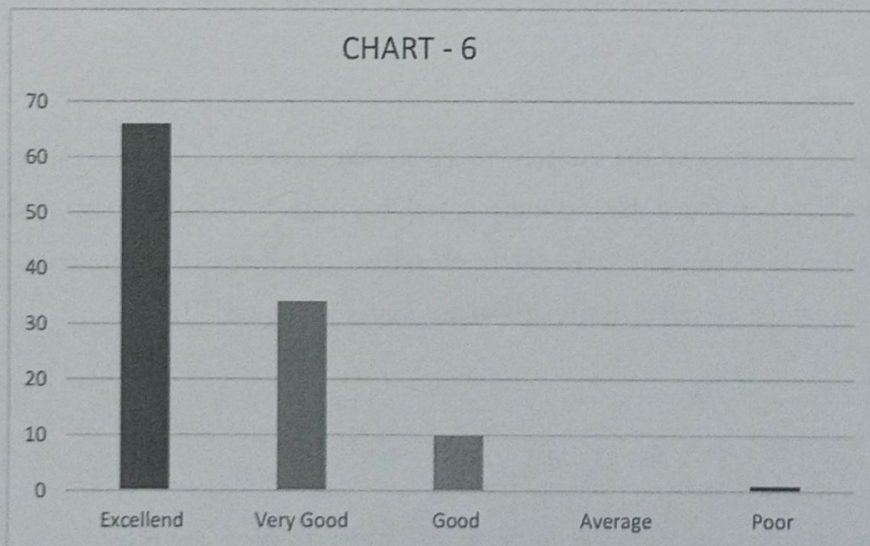
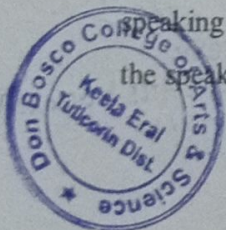


6. The teaching methods and instructional strategies used in the spoken English course were effective in helping me grasp and apply new concepts

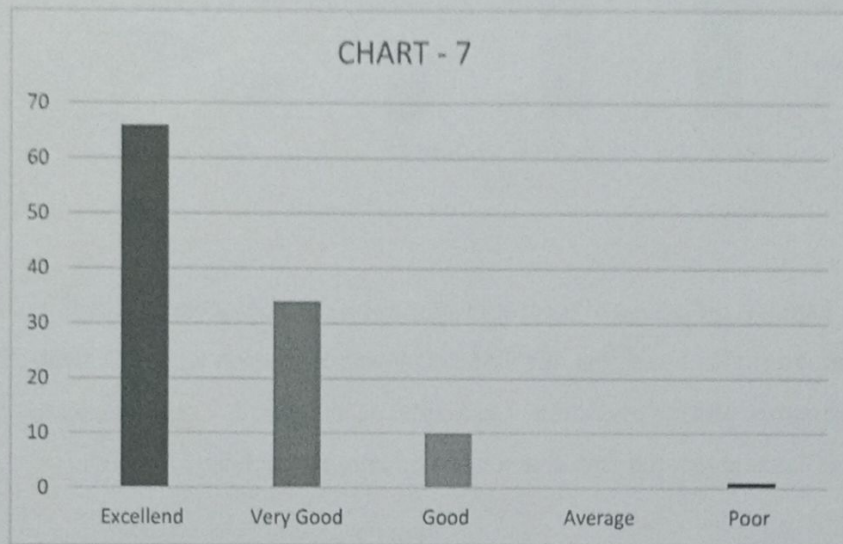


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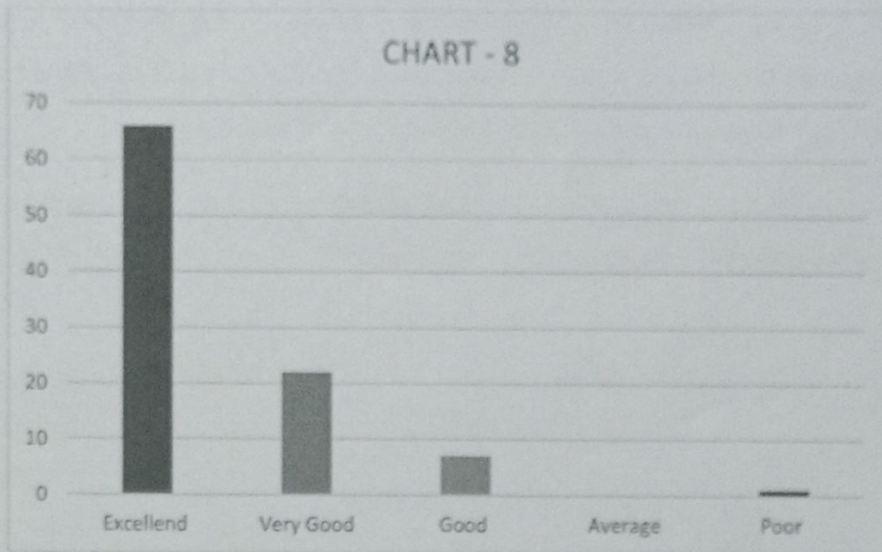
