இளைஞர்களின் நண்பனும் வழிகாட்டியும்

ஓரன்போஸ்கோ 1815 ஆகஸ்ட் 16ஆம் நாள் இத்தாலி நாட்டில் பெக்கி என்னும் குக்கிராமத்தில் பிறந்தார். அவர் பிரான்சிஸ் போஸ்கோ மற்றும் மார்க்ரெட் ஆகியோரின் குக்கராயத்தை ஆவார். ஜான் இரண்டு வயது இருக்கும் போது அவரது தந்தை இறந்து இளையமான மூர்க்ரெட் நோய்வாய்ப்பட்ட மாமியார், ஒரு கைக்குழந்தை மற்றும் இரண்டு மகன்களுடன் ஒரு பண்ணையில் வாழ்ந்து வந்தார்.

ஒன்பது வயதாக இருக்கும்போது போஸ்கோ ஒரு கனவு கண்டார். அக்கனவில் இளையோரை அன்பில் ஆட்கொள்ள வேண்டும் என அவருக்கு அருளப்பட்டது. 1841 ஆம் ஆண்டு அவரது 26வது வயதில் குருவாகத் திருநிலைப்படுத்தப்பட்ட போது தனது கனவு நனவானதை தொன்போஸ்கோ உணர்ந்தார்.

இளையோர் மேல் அக்கறை உள்ள குருவாக இருக்க விரும்புகிறேன் என்ற விருதுவாக்குடன் தமது பணி வாழ்வைத் தொழிற்சாலை நகரமான தூரினில் முதலில் துவங்கினார். அவர் துவங்கிய முதல் மாணவர் இல்லம் ஒரு புறக்கணிக்கப்பட்ட கட்டடித்தில் அமைந்திருந்தது. அவர் அந்த இல்லத்தில் கல்வியோடு தொழிற்கல்வியையும் கற்றுக்கொடுத்தார். அவரது பணியில் அவரது அன்னை மார்க்ரெட்டும், தன்னை இணைத்துக்

தொன்போஸ்கோ தமது மாணவர்களையும், உதவியாளர்களையும், தம்முடைய பணியில் ஈடுபடுத்தினார். கல்வி என்பது இதயத்தைச் சார்ந்தது என்பதை நம்பினார். அவருடைய கல்விமுறையானது மூன்று கூறுகளாக வேரூன்றப்பட்டது. அவையாவன: அறிவு ஆன்மீகம் மற்றும் அன்பு. வரலாற்று அறிஞர்கள், தொன்போஸ்கோவை சமூக ஞானியாகவும், புனிதர் மற்றும் கல்வியாளராகவும் கருதுகின்றனர். பொதுமக்கள், அவரை ஒரு எழுத்தாளராகவும் மற்றும் ஆன்மீக எண்ணம் கொண்டோர் தொன்போஸ்கோவை சித்தர், மற்றும் தீர்க்கதரிசி என்றும் அழைப்பார்கள். திருச்சபையினரும் மற்றும் உளவியவாளர்களும் அவருடைய தீர்க்கதரிசனக் கனவுகள் மற்றும் அதிசயங்களைப் பற்றி ஆக்கரியப்படுகின்றனர்.

இளையோரை வழிகாட்டும் பணியில் அவர் சிறந்து விளங்கினார். இளைஞருடைய ஆன்ம குருவாக அவர்களில் மன அமைதியும் மகிழ்ச்சியும் நிறைந்திருக்கச் செய்தார். திருச்சபை தொன் போஸ்கோவை புனிதராக அறிவித்து அவரை இளைஞர்களின் தந்தையும், ஆசானாகவும் பிரகடனப்படுத்தியது.

கொள்போள்கோவின் சமேசியர்கள்

தொன்போஸ்கோ தோற்றிவித்த சலேசிய சபைக் குருக்கள் மற்றும் சகோதரர்கள் சீலகியர்கள் என்று அழைக்கப்படுகின்றனர். இன்றும் பல வருடங்களைக் கடந்து அவரது பணிகள் 132 நாடுகளில் 15000க்கும் மேற்பட்ட சலேசியர்களைக் கொண்டு இணைஞர்களுக்குச் சேவை செய்து வருகின்றது.

தொன்போஸ்கோவின் சமேசியர்கள் 1906 ஆம் ஆண்டு இந்தியாவில் அடியெடுத்து வைத்தனர். சுமார் 2400 சவேசியர்கள் 575 நிறுவனங்களில் இந்தியாவிலுள்ள அனைத்து மாநிலங்களிலும் இளைஞர்களின் நலன்களுக்காகப் பணியாற்றி வருகின்றார்கள். பல்கலைக்கழகம், பள்ளிகள், கல்லூரிகள், தொழிற்க்கல்வி நிறுவனங்கள், தொழில் நுட்பக் கல்லூர்கள். இளைஞர்கள் மையம், பங்குத்தளங்கள் மற்றும் இதர இளைஞர் தொடர்பான திடக்கள் போன்ற எண்ணிலடங்கா பணிகளில் சலேசியர்கள் பணியாற்றி வருகின்றனர். இந்தியர்களாக் பெற்தும் நேகிக்கப்பட்ட தொன் போஸ்கோவின் கல்விமுறை எண்ணற்ற இனைவர்களின் வாழ்க்கைமுறையை மாற்றியமைத்திருக்கின்றது.

DON BOSCO

Father and Educator of Youth

John Bosco was born on 16th August 1815 at a little hamlet called Becchi, in northern Italy. He was the youngest son of Francesco Bosco and Margeret Occhiena. When John was two, his father died, and despite all odds, John wanted an education to become a priest. When he was nine, Bosco had the first of a series of dreams which would play an influential role in his work and outlook. The man in the dream said to him: 'You will have to win these friends of yours not with blows, but with gentleness and kindness. At fourteen, he found a tutor. At fifteen, he began taking jobs of any kind to pay for lodging and school. At the age of twenty six, he realized his dream of becoming a priest in 1841.

Don Bosco's capability to attract numerous boys and adult helpers was connected to his "Preventive System of Education". He believed education to be a "matter of the heart" and said that the boys must not only be loved, but know that they are loved. His system of education was rooted on three components, namely, Reason, Religion and Loving Kindness.

Historians know him as a social innovator, saint and educator and common people claim him as a publisher and builder. Religious minded people claim him as a clairvoyant, visionary and prophet. Churchmen and psychologists wonder at the catalogue of his prophetic dreams and miracle. But his special mission was the care of youth. He gave them food, enriched their minds, taught them trades and filled their souls with peace and joy. The Church has proclaimed him a saint and the "Father and Teacher of Youth". Salesians of Don Bosco (SDB) in India

Don Bosco founded a religious society of priests and brothers whom he called "Salesians". Today they are known as the "Salesians of Don Bosco" Over the years, Don Bosco's works have multiplied and spread and today the Salesians are about 16,000, serving the youth in about 130 countries.

Don Bosco's followers arrived in India in the year 1906 and today their mission is spread in almost all the states of India with nearly 2400 Salesians working in 575 institutions for the welfare of the young people. Salesian works in India include a university, number of colleges and professional institutes, an academic school, technical institutions, youth centres, parishes and other youth related projects. Don Bosco is much loved in India and his system of education has transformed the lives of millions of young people.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

College Etiquette

- Use of mobile phones is strictly prohibited inside the campus.
- Students shall keep the college campus clean and the class rooms neat
- Students attending lectures in class rooms or attending meetings, etc. shall maintain silence.
- Students getting out during class hours for extra-curricular activities shall do it in an orderly manner without making any noise.
- Students shall handle the college properties with care and cause no damage to them. The cost of the repairs of the damaged goods will be met by the students concerned.
- Students are allowed to use laptops only with the permission and supervision of staff.
- When a member of the staff enters the classroom students shall get up and remain standing till they are requested to sit down. They shall likewise stand up when the staff leaves the class.
- Students are expected to bring the prescribed books and study materials for the class.
- Every student shall sit in the place assigned to him/her in the classroom.
- 10. Students coming late to the class shall enter only with the permission of the HOD.
- 11. No notice or petition of any kind shall be circulated among the students or pasted on the notice board or anywhere within the college premises without the prior permission of the Principal.
- 12. Long absentees shall not be allowed to sit for examinations as per the rules of the university. (Refer Attendance and Leave Section)
- 13. Disobedience, lack of response to class work and obscenity in word or deed are considered detrimental to discipline and will be severely dealt with.
- 14. Ragging, eve-teasing, smoking and using tobacco are serious offences which will be handled by the police department.
- 15. The Principal retains the power to take appropriate measures including punitive action depending on the gravity of the transgressions, such as fines, withholding of term certificates, suspension or expulsion.
- 16. English is the spoken and administrative language in the campus. Students need to learn to converse in English as it enhances opportunities for higher studies and careers.

Dress Code : Boys

- Low hip pants are not allowed.
- Shirt should be TUCKED-IN and IDENTITY-CARD should be worn in 2.
- Hair should be cut in decent manner avoiding designs, colours and
- marks on the head. Jeans pants, casuals and T-shirts are not permitted inside the campus
- Wearing bands and ropes in hands are not encouraged.
- Nose-studs and Ear-rings are not permitted.
- Wear only formal attire inside the campus. 6.

Dress Code: Girls

- Double folded shawl should be pinned at both the shoulders and IDENTITY-CARD should be worn.
- Net shawl and net handed chudithars are not allowed.
- 2. High side cuts in chudithar tops are not allowed. 3.
- Transparent chudithars, white pants and leggings are not allowed. 4.
- Noisy anklets and short tops are not allowed. 5.
- No low neck in front and back of the chudithars and back ropes are not 6.
- Free hair and pony tail hair styles are not allowed.

Attendance and Leave

- 1. Attendance will be marked at the beginning of each class hour. A student who is not in class when attendance is marked shall loss the attendance to the session. Missing FIVE CLASS HOURS will be counted as ONE DAY loss of attendance.
- 2. Students need to attend at least 75 percent of the lectures in each semester to be able to appear for semester examinations. Those with 60 to 75 percent attendance need to pay a condonation fee fixed by the university. Those with attendance below 60 percent are not allowed to appear for university examinations. Such students need to REPEAT the semester with RE-ADMISSION as per the rules of the uiniversity
- 3. No student shall absent himself / herself from the college without leave application. In case of sickness for more than THREE days, a medical certificate is to be submitted.
- 4. Application for leave should be made in time to HOD which must be countersigned by parent / guardian / warden.
- 5. Student absenting himself / herself from the college for more than TEN consecutive working days without satisfactory explanation is liable to have his / her name struck off from the rolls.

PAYMENT OF FEES

- Fees are to be paid in TAMIL NADU MERCANTILE BANK LTD., by challan and the College Copy is to be submitted to the college Accountant. The Student copy of the Challan is to be preserved and produced when rquired.
- Online fees payment can be done through the college website.
- The last dates for the payment of fees are mentioned in the college calendar.
- Fees once paid will not be refunded.
- Every student shall be liable to pay fee for the whole course if he/she leaves in the middle of the course.

SCHOLARSHIPS

- 1. Scholarship for SC / ST Students: Scholarships sanctioned by the Director of Adi-Dravidar Welfare Department can cover all the non-refundable fees to be paid by students of the scheduled caste and scheduled tribes.
- Farmer Scholarship: Scholarship sanctioned for the children of farmers.
- Scholarship for Minority Students: Scholarships are awarded by the Central Government on the basis of marks scored in the higher secondary examination. The eligible students should contact the Scholarship Desk and apply for the scholarships by submitting the income certificate and community certificate.

- 5. Our college management scholarship: Our management too has extended financial assistance to the deserving poor students through the following schemes.
 - (a) Work scholarship, an innovative program of our college that offers work and earn for about 500 students every year.
 - (b) Education loan scheme to poor students to complete their course.
 - (c) Boss (Bosco student solidarity fund) is a charity foundation established out of the generous contribution from the staff & students.

Identity Card

Every student shall obtain his/her identity card duly attested by the Principal and shall keep the card with him / her throughout his/her course of study. He / She shall be required to produce the identification card for all purposes when warranted. Each student shall keep his / her identification card at the time of university examination along with his/her hall ticket.

Library Rules

- 1. The library can be used by all the staff and students of the college,
- 2. It is kept open from 9 am to 4.30 pm on all working days and Saturdays
- 3. Strict silence shall be maintained in the library.
- 4. It is essential to sign in the Entry Register before entering the library.
- 5. Note books and other books are not to be carried into the library.
- 6. A maximum of three books only can be borrowed at a time for a period of 10 days only.
- 7. Borrowed books can however be renewed once for another 10 days. provided they are not required by any other student.
- 8. For books retained beyond the due date, a fine of Rs.5/- will be collected per day per book.
- 9. Full compensation will be collected for damage or loss of the books.
- 10. Students shall on receiving books, examine them and report to the Librarian any damage found therein. If they fail to do so they will be held responsible for such damage as may be detected afterwards.
- 11. Students shall not write, underline or make any mark in the Library book.
- 12. Any infringements of the rules may lead to the forfeiture of the privilege to use the Library.
- 13. Every year Best Library users are honored on the college annual day.
