#### INTRODUCTION

The Don Bosco Educational Institutions spread throughout the world are widely renowned for quality education that combines knowledge, skills, values and attitudes and prepares the youth especially the poor, irrespective of caste and creed, for a successful career and a meaningful life. The DON BOSCO COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE, KEELA ERAL, a Christian minority, self-financing, co-educational institution of higher education, affiliated to the Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli, was established in the year 2013 and is managed by the Salesians of Don Bosco belonging to the Indian Province of Trichy.

The college is committed towards fulfilling its motto "**To Enlighten and Empower**" the poor rural youth and is taking effective steps, firmly and steadily in its long journey towards the peaks of educational excellence, ensuring expansion, inclusion and social transformation in the Southern Districts of Tamil Nadu.

The 483 students of our college from the Six UG courses and one PG course, 33 teaching and non-teaching staff and 8 Salesians constitute an academic community, fondly referred to as the DBCAS family. As our college is marching in the ninth year of excellence, we are celebrating the seventh Annual Day by reminiscing about the memorable moments of the past year.

The COVID'19 pandemic has affected the normal running and activities of the college significantly as in the case of every other sector of the society. But at the same time, it has opened up new possibilities of teaching and learning.

**AUXILIUM GIRLS' HOSTEL:** The Auxilium Hostel for Girls is managed by the Salesian sisters in the Auxilium School Campus. The hostel assures the safety of the girls who may be from faraway places. Under the guidance of Rev. Sr. P. Arockia Mary, the Hostel Warden the girl students are taken care of. Presently there are 24 Students in the hostel. Personal attention is given to the academic performance and the overall health of each student in the hostel.
