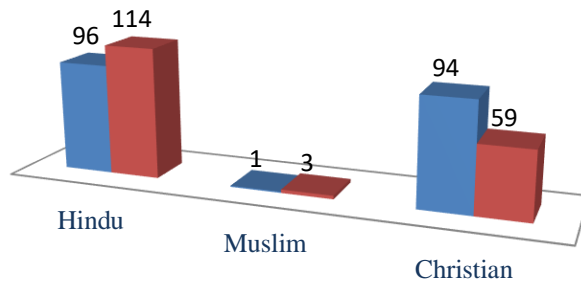
Student Strength(Gender-wise)

■ Male ■ Female



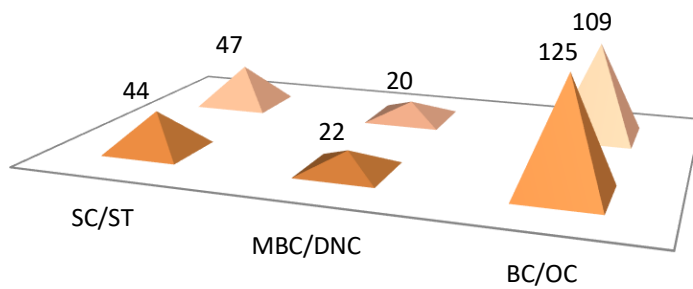
Student Strength (Religion-wise)

■ Boys ■ Girls

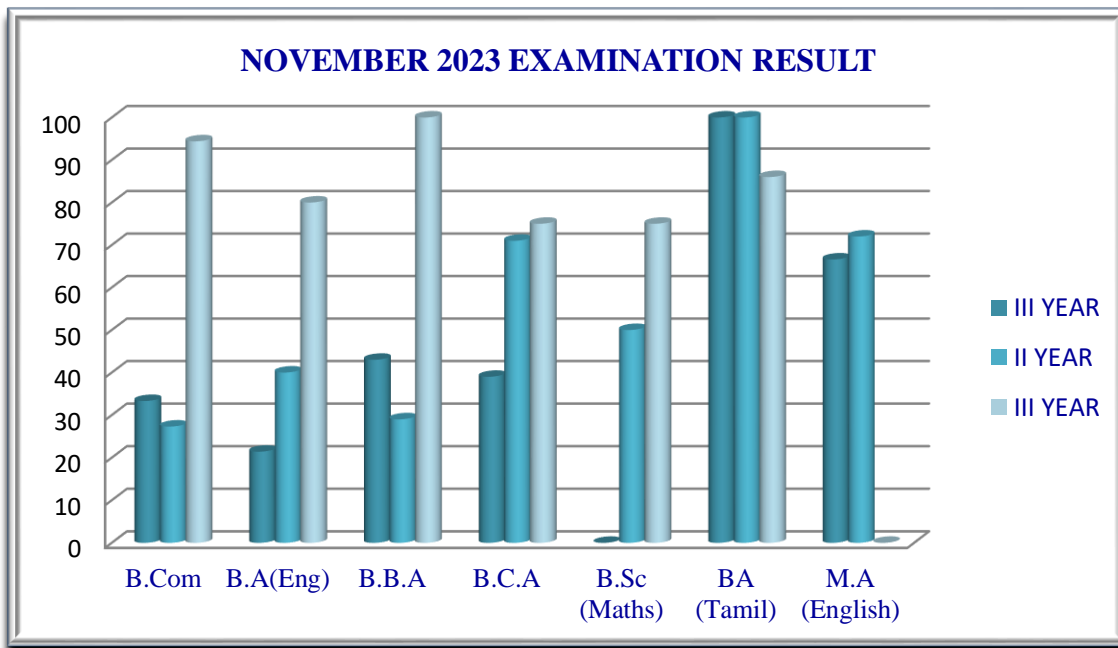
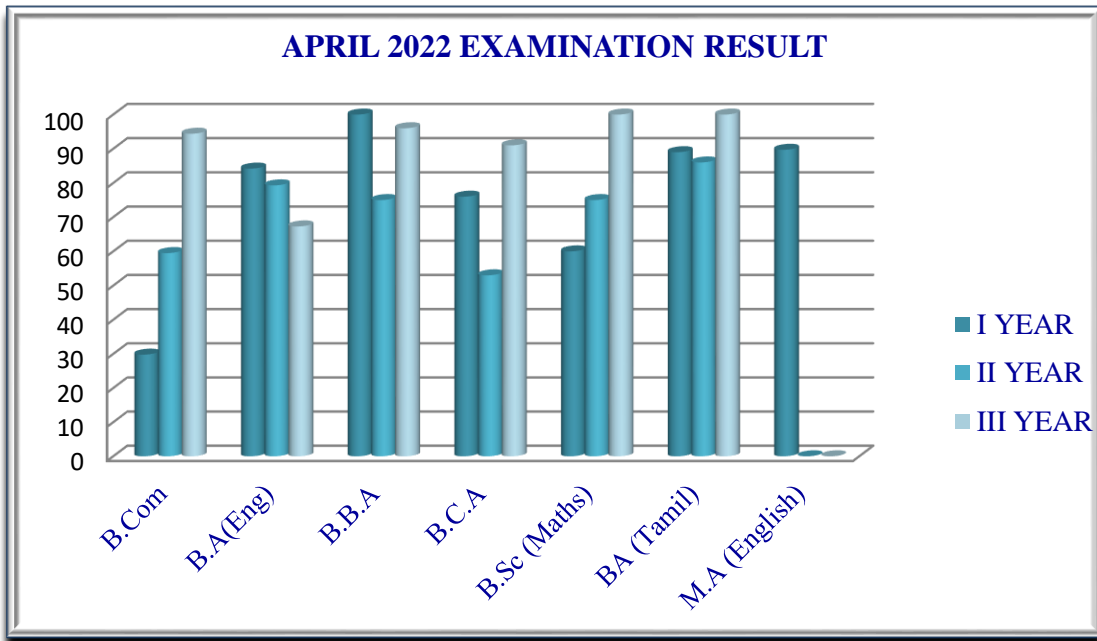


Student Strength Community-wise

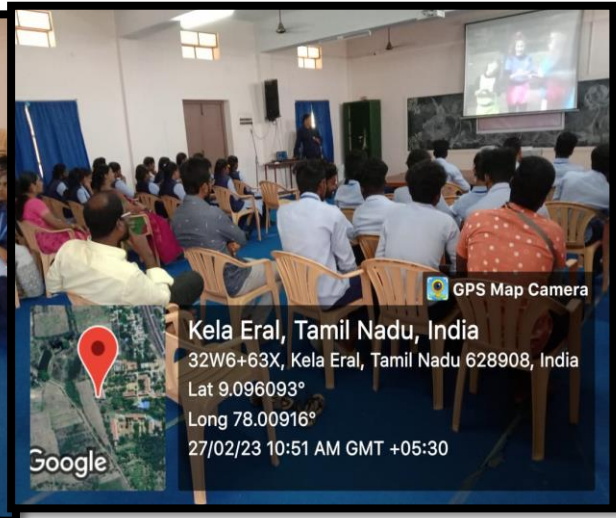


ENGLISH - BELA ASSOCIATION ACTIVITIES:

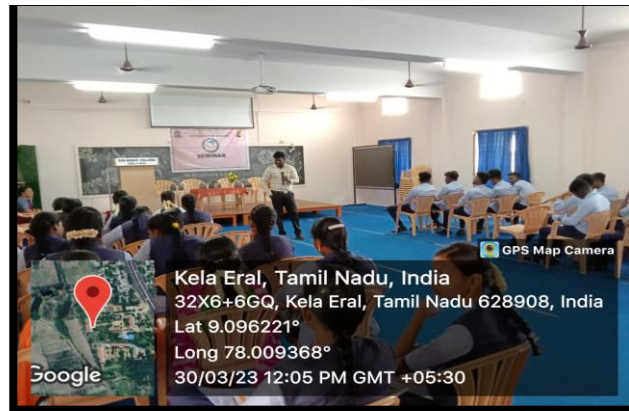

The library of Don Bosco College of Arts and Science has been functioning since the year 2013. The library fulfils its aim of satisfying the quest of learning of the students. New Library block with the estimation of 52 lakhs was opened on 21 January 2017. The DBCAS Library contains 9806 volumes and titles of books. The Library subscribes to 08 National Journals, 05 International Journals, 05 National Magazines, 06 Newspapers and 60 CDs Books are classified and arranged according to the Dewey Decimal Classification scheme (DDC).

➔ **Automation:**

Our Library services are fully automated through using the Library Nirmal Software Package. Rupees 10,000 was given to Nimal institute for installing the Software 25.06.2017. The circulation system is fully computerized and all the documents are Bar-coded.

➔ **Access to Computerized Library Catalogue (OPAC);**

The Library has a computerized catalogue which provides online access to the users. It is of help to the users to search the documents by way of Author, Title, publisher, Department and Subject wise.

➔ **Access System:**

The Library follows Open Access System. The users are free to enter the stack room and can choose the books of their choice, the reading materials are arranged as per the Dewey decimal classification. Shelf guides list are provided at the stack racks. The users can search the books and reserve the books through OPAC.

SCHOLARSHIP

The Government has come out with a great deal of student scholarship and other financial help to large number of students to enable them to get higher education for the upliftment of the society. The college acts as mediator between the Government and students in getting the financial help as offered by the State Government in form of Scholarship and others. But we feel that such support from Government level alone is not sufficient Multi dimension poverty on the way of higher education may not be eradicated only by such Government eve initiatives. Observing that section of students who are not belonging under the umbrella of Government level support mechanism but poor, college made an effort to identity and support them from its own fund in terms of Half/Full waiver of college tuition fee. The college always tries to remove the financial barriers of the financially poor and needy students by enabling them to get full fee and half fee scholarship from the college fund.
